- 1. Take I-495 east and get off at exit 38 (curved exit) to take Northern State Parkway east.
- 2. On the Northern State Pkwy, move to right (the exit merged to the left side of the parkway)
- 3. Get off at exit 31A to take Meadow Brook Parkway (south). (* Northern state Parkway splits into two, so take the right side to merge into Meadow Brook Pkwy)
- 4. Take Exit M4 (sign reads "Hempstead" and "Coliseum", Hempstead Turnpike West)
- 5. It is a long exit. Follow "NCC" sign.
- 6. Road merges into "Charles Lindbergh Boulevard.
- 7. Drive a half mile, and make right at the first traffic light which leads to NCC main parking lot.
- 8. Ask someone where is the CCB Building is.
