To receive a Certificate of Merit for one of your deserving chemistry students please complete and submit (by mail or fax) the enclosed form as soon as possible, but by no later than May 17.

In extraordinary circumstances we can provide more than one certificate to a school. If you need more than one certificate please duplicate the enclosed form. Return the forms and provide an explanation as to why you are requesting multiple certificates. Please be aware that a request for multiple certificates does not guarantee that they will be provided; each request will be evaluated on an individual basis. The certificate(s) will be sent to the teacher listed on the form as soon as possible.
