

The Cooper Union School of Engineering: Adjunct Faculty Position in Chemistry

The Albert Nerken School of Engineering at the Cooper Union is perennially ranked among the nation's top undergraduate engineering schools. It is comprised of four degree-granting departments: Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering and Chemical Engineering.
