11. 2019 Chair's report: Please provide a narrative of the past year's activity/successes/challenges:\*

Mission Statement for the New York Section states we will be a forum for the exchange of ideas, knowledge and experiences among those interested in the Chemical Sciences in ways that promote individual and professional excellence in the Chemical Community. This theme permeates our activities. The NYACS is proud of the long-standing traditions established throughout the 128-year history as well as the dedication to change as needed to better serve our members. We offer a variety of opportunities for our members to participate in technical and social activities. In 2019 we had 4 active Subsections: Brooklyn (2 events), Hudson-Bergen (2 events), Long Island (16 events), and Westchester (10 events), 11 active Topical Discussion Groups: Analytical (1 event), Biochemical (7 events), High School Teachers (6 events), Inorganic and Organometallic (2 events), Metrowomen Chemists (1 event), Microwave (2 events), Nanoscience (3 events), Organic (2 events), Senior Chemists (1 event), Younger Chemists (4 events) and Computers in Chemistry (1 event). NYACS held in total about 97 events. We were able to reestablish an inactive Rockland subsection and the Computers in Chemistry Topical Group. Governing the NYACS requires 11 active Executive Committees, and 2 active Coordinating Committees (Eastern Analytical Symposium and MARM Steering). In addition, professional development opportunities are presented. The ACS Leadership Institute courses are offered to Chair-Elect and YCC Chair. The Younger Chemists Committee had workshops on building a personal brand and networking for early career professionals. The YCC best event was made possible by a 2019 Innovative Project Grant awarded to NYACS. It activated a group of younger members by giving them the opportunity to interact with representatives of industry and Brookhaven National Laboratory. In addition to the activities above, we participate in the governance of scientific societies like the ACS and the Eastern Analytical Symposium and recognize excellence through award processes. All Councilors from the NYACS participated at both the Spring and Fall national meetings and 24 New York Section members serve on 22 different National ACS Committees.

One of the premier events of the NYACS is the William H. Nichols Medal Distinguished Symposium and Award Dinner. The Nichols Medal Award was established in 1902 by Dr. William H. Nichols to honor a chemical scientist for outstanding original research and was first awarded in 1903. 250 scientists, students and guests attended this event in 2019. The Sectionwide Conference provides an opportunity to recognize those volunteers who have made major contributions to the success of the NY ACS through the Outstanding Service Award. 75 members and guests (including high school Project SEED students with poster displays) participated. In 2019, besides the traditional Nichols High School Teacher Award, NYACS was able to announce for the first year the winners of the 3 newly established Outstanding College Teachers Awards. In 2019, 2 NYACS members received the honor of ACS Fellow Award. One NYACS member received an ACS Outreach Volunteer of the Year Award and one member received the national 2019 Radding Award.

We promote excellence in society primarily through out public outreach, both national and international, and our commitment to the next generation of scientists through educational activities. In 2019, the NYACS unveiled a giant 3D Periodic Table at New York Hall of Science, as its members commemorated the 150th Birthday of Mendeleev's Periodic Table and the International Year of the Periodic Table (IYPT2019). This event was an excellent example of bringing together the community of thousands of NYACS volunteers representing 56 organizations, ranging from research labs, universities, colleges, high schools, chemical companies and business centers, participated in and contributed to the designs of the 118 elements and construction of the Table. Another great event, Periodic Table People Science Cafe, involved many students from various high schools celebrating the 2019 IYPT in a fun, sweet and interesting way. Another outstanding event is the Chemists Celebrate Earth Week Seminar and Parade. 225 participants (including middle school students) from 25 different institutions were informed about environmental challenges concerning paper industry, and then participated in a march across the Brooklyn Bridge to raise awareness of these

|                                                     | <p>challenges.</p> <p>The NYACS has several significant activities for middle school and high school students. The High School Teacher Topical Group met 6 times. 384 students registered for the US National Chemistry Olympiad. 58 students from 4 different high schools presented 22 posters at the 2019 Chemagination. The 2019 National Chemistry Week Chemistry Spectacular had 25 prestigious colleges, universities, industries, business centers, and nonprofit organizations participate through 380 volunteers to serve 1600 attendees! One of the most significant activities is through Project SEED. The NY section had 18 SEED 2 and 36 SEED 1 participants! All the NY SEED senior students were accepted to college and all are pursuing careers in the STEM fields.</p> <p>The NYACS also supports many activities for college level students. The premier event is the Undergraduate Research Symposium. This event provides an opportunity for undergraduate students to present their original research findings. 246 people attended in 2019. The 98 abstracts were submitted by students from 25 different universities and colleges and presented in 19 concurrent sessions. This year NYACS facilitated the visit of 15 students and 2 mentors from La Salle University, Mexico in the Illumination Space Advanced Science Research Center at the New York University.</p> <p>Additionally, NYLS organized a party feting 26 years of service of the retiring office administrator and performed a successful search for a new candidate for this positon. The NYLS maintains an active social media presence. The number of Facebook followers keeps increasing with spikes around important NYACS events like the Nichols, URS or NCW. The NY ACS website typically has 20 users/day (1 min 22 sec on average); 102 a week, 420 a month with spikes up to 79 users/day, with Tuesday 3-4 pm as most popular time (25 users).</p> <p>The biggest challenge facing the NYACS is the aging demographic of the section. It seems to be a critical time of a transitioning from the old to the new guard. A good number of long-time volunteers and affiliates are stepping down and new, younger and less experienced members are stepping up to leadership roles.</p> <p>Another challenge facing the NYACS is the budget running into the deficit mode in the future with decreased or flat current income. The NY Board is committed to a conservative budget in order to keep supporting all of the programs at the same level in the future. Better involvement of industrial chemists could alleviate this problem.</p> |

This theme permeates our activities. The NYACS is proud of the long-standing traditions established throughout the 128-year history as well as the dedication to better serve our members through change as needed.</p> <p>We offer a wide variety of opportunities for our members to participate in technical and social activities. In 2019 we had 4 active Subsections (40 events) and 11 active Topical Discussion Groups (33 events) and at least 99 events. We were able to reestablish an inactive Rockland subsection and the Computers in Chemistry Topical Group. Governing the NYACS requires 11 active Executive and 2 Coordinating Committees (MARM and EAS). We actively participate in the governance of the ACS. All NYACS Councilors participated at both the Spring and Fall national meetings. 24 NY ACS members serve on 22 different National ACS Committees.</p> <p>One of the NYACS premier events is the William H. Nichols Medal Distinguished Symposium and Award Dinner. In 2019, 250 scientists, students and guests attended this event. The Sectionwide Conference provides an opportunity to recognize those volunteers who have made major contributions through the Outstanding Service Award. 75 members and guests (including high school Project SEED students with poster displays) participated. In 2019, besides the traditional Nichols High School Teacher Award, NYACS was able to announce for the first year the winners of the 3 newly established Outstanding College Teachers Awards at three different levels. In 2019, 2 NYACS members were awarded the honors of ACS Fellows, one NYACS member received an ACS Outreach Volunteer of the Year Award and prof. Orna received the 2019 Radding Award. The Young Chemists Committee was especially active in 2019. The YCC best event was made possible by a 2019 Innovative Project Grant awarded to NYACS. It activated a group of younger members by giving them the opportunity to interact with representatives of industry and Brookhaven National Laboratory.</p> <p>We promote excellence in society primarily through out public outreach, both national and international, and our commitment to the next generation of scientists through educational activities. Some of these activities include Project SEED, CCEW, Chemistry Olympiad, Chemagination, or Research Poster Sessions and Awards' Dinners for the high school and college students. In 2019, the NYACS unveiled a giant 3D Periodic Table at New York Hall of Science, as its members commemorated the 150th Birthday of Mendeleev's Periodic Table and the International Year of the Periodic Table (IYPT2019). This event was an excellent example of bringing together the community of thousands of NYACS volunteers representing 56 organizations, ranging from research labs, universities, colleges, high schools, chemical companies and business centers, participated in and contributed to the designs of the 118 elements and construction of the Table. Another great event, Periodic Table People, involved students from various high schools celebrating the 2019 IYPT in a fun, sweet and interesting way.</p> <p>The NYLS maintains an active social media presence. The number of Facebook followers keeps increasing with spikes around important NYACS events like the Nichols, URS or NCW.</p> |
